community dinner, Laura Ramirez, Gisela Alvarado and Julisa Alvarez. The dinner proceeds (over \$1,000!) were given directly to




Colin and Marla Williams. Finally, thank you to the many parent volunteers, led by Melissa Uzri and Lillian Ayroso, for coordinating the
